Stone age, era, cave, woolly mammoth, extinct, prehistoric, Stonehenge, cave painting.






Science: Light and Shadows

Key facts:

The main source of light is the sun. A shadow is an absence of light. If light cannot get through an object, the surface on the other side of that object (for example, the ground or a wall) will have less light reaching it. Sunlight that travels towards the Earth takes just over 8 minutes to reach us

Light travels in a straight line until it hits something. Sometimes, it travels a short distance. Other times, light travels thousands of years - like the light from stars we see in the Milky Way.
