Maths


This term we spend more time focusing on teen numbers. We want to make sure that when we head to year 1 that we are fully equipped to start the year with as much maths knowledge as possible!

We will also do lots more subitising, which is our ability to identify amounts without counting them, and knowing that, for example, number 7 is made up of 4 and 3, or 5 and 2.


Writing / Reading targets for
