Topic

Key facts:

The stone age era began 2.5 million years ago and ended 2500 BC. Stone age humans lived in caves moved on to building huts. Stone age people made their own tools. Cave paintings were created during the Stone Age era. The Iron Age began in 800BC and ended with the Roman invasion in 43AD. In the Iron Age, the first hill forts were constructed, and farming communities were built.

Science: Light and Shadows

Key facts:

The main source of light is the sun. A shadow is an absence of light. If light cannot get through an object, the surface on the other side of that object (for example, the ground or a wall) will have less light reaching it. Sunlight that travels towards the Earth takes just over 8 minutes to reach us.

Light travels in a straight line until it hits something. Sometimes, it travels a short distance. Other times, light travels thousands of years - like the light from stars we see in the Milky Way.
